Pingali Venkayya is the father of the original form of our tricolor which we see today. Born on 2 August 1876 in a village near the Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh, Pingali Venkayya was entrusted with the task of making the national flag by Mahatma Gandhi. In 1921 he prepared the flag. Some changes were made to it in the year 1931. The national flag of India was adopted in its original form on 22 July 1947.
